# URGENT VS. IMPORTANT PART II

Congratulations to all my students who entered the Keyboard Exams this year. All who enrolled took the test, and all passed! It was a gratifying year. But I'd be lying if I said there was no **urgency** brought on by lack of advance preparation.

We are now building repertoire toward competition/performance season. Along with learning repertoire, it is essential that the skills gained in October's exam are not lost or ignored. These **important** skills exist to support repertoire – let's use them.

Ideally, the daily practice session includes:

- ✓ 2 scales
- ✓ 2 arpeggios
- ✓ 1 4-measure sight reading example
- ✓ 1 slow play-through of rep
- $\checkmark$  1 "scrubbing" of two measures
