## Parent's Practice Tip # 34:

## Equipment and Settings (deep breath)



As we learn, learn, learn, and then learn more, about how to communicate with online video conferencing, there are simple and inexpensive ways to improve both the quality of the lesson and the audience experience of your child's performances.

**Purchasing an external microphone greatly improves your sound quality.** I suggest a Blue Snowball, or any of the suggestions found on Peabody's Remote Teaching and Learning pages, easily googled with those words. **Further, there are several settings to adjust in Zoom**: first ensure that your external mic is on, plugged in, and selected. Then enable original sound, turn off automatic volume control, disable all "background noise" settings, put "echo cancellation" on "auto." I have a pdf from Peabody that walks you through these settings in case you cannot find them under advanced settings.

**Simple tips**: Power the device down and back up; ensure other applications are turned off, ask family not to overload the internet during lessons, and to avoid it during performances.

Many heartfelt thanks to the children and families who participated in the Summer Concert for Those We Love. It was enthusiastically received, including by informed patrons of the Candlelight Concert Society, and at least one veteran Peabody professor. Let's keep up the good work, and share our music again in the fall.
