Tip #35: Preparing for Performance



I am taking a class called Performance Psychology Essentials for Educators. A notable visual in the class dealt with available brainpower vs. the amount of this space used for the task at hand. How do we manage our thoughts when a task is so practiced that it leaves plenty of thinking leftover for trouble, for the student to start cooking novel concerns? A few techniques involve old chestnuts we use here: learning our pieces by hands alone memory, and eyes closed. Another technique is performing A LOT to learn how to control thoughts under pressure. Another great preparation technique is "Anticipatory Auditory Imagery," or mental choreography, where the performer plans minutely what to think about at each juncture of the piece. Yet again, reframing "anxiety" as "excitement" is powerful. Your child will use some of these techniques. If you're further curious, please give me a call!
