Parent's Practice Tip # 43:

HEAR THIS/SAY THAT: easy solutions for parents



You hear: The same piece played at high speed repeatedly from the beginning to a favorite stopping point. (This never happens, right?)

You say: Pull out a trouble spot and practice only it for 5 minutes OR Practice from the stopping point forward by 16 measures OR Play this for me slow and staccato once OR Please play the scale of the piece AND its relative major/minor AND the arpeggio OR Call Madame Hélène now.

You hear: No practicing for days. And days.

You say: Let me hear you practice for 5 minutes only OR Play me your favorite piece from this week/month/year OR When exactly is the next repertoire class? OR Let's talk to Madame Hélène about choosing new repertoire.
